AN ORDINANCE CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT OF JOSEPH WHITELY AS ENGINEERING TECHNICAL AIDE I IN THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 22-91 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of the Civil Service provisions of the Codified Ordinances of Avon Lake, tests have been given and an eligibility list established for the position of Engineering Technical Aide I; and the Mayor and Human Resources Director have submitted to this Council for confirmation an appointment to said position.

## NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON LAKE, STATE OF OHIO:

- <u>Section No. 1:</u> That the appointment of Joseph Whitely to the position of Engineering Technical Aide I in the Public Works Department be, and it is hereby approved and confirmed.
- <u>Section No. 2:</u> That the duties and responsibilities to be performed and undertaken by the Engineering Technical Aide I in the Public Works Department shall be those set forth in Ordinance No. 21-167.
- <u>Section No. 3:</u> That with Council's present knowledge of Mr. Whitely's experience and ability, it has and does hereby fix a Step 3 rate of \$34.44/hour payable bi-weekly, effective November 21, 2022.
  - Section No. 4: That Ordinance No. 22-91 is hereby repealed.
- Section No. 5: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- <u>Section No. 6:</u> That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the necessary to fully staff the Public Works Department to ensure the efficient operation of the department and to continue to offer quality services, thus for preservation of the public peace, health, and welfare of the residents of the City of Avon Lake. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
