

AN ORDINANCE RATIFYING THE REDUCTION TO THE CONTRACT WITH PRECISION PAVING, INC. FOR THE WALKER ROAD PAVING PROJECT PHASE 2 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City engaged Precision Paving, Inc. of Milan, Ohio for the Walker Road Paving Project Phase 2; and

WHEREAS, that upon the completion of the Walker Road Paving Project Phase 2, the City Engineer reviewed the expenditures of the project and has recommended a deduct change order to the contract with Precision Paving, Inc. in the amount of \$48,409.59; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to confirm, adopt, and ratify this reduction to the contract.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF AVON LAKE, STATE OF OHIO:

Section No. 1: That Council hereby confirms, adopts, and ratifies a deduct change order to the contract with Precision Paving, Inc. of Milan, Ohio in the amount of \$48,409.59, and that said deduct change order is hereby approved and accepted.

Section No. 2: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section No. 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the necessity of approving a deduct change order to the contract for asphalt paving, thus for the health, safety, and welfare of the public. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
