AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING PAYMENT TO TYLER TECHNOLOGIES, INC., FOR SOFTWARE SUPPORT AND LICENSING OF THE CITY'S FINANCIAL SOFTWARE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City's financial software is licensed and supported by Tyler Technologies, Inc., of Dallas, Texas; and

WHEREAS, Tyler Technologies, Inc., of Dallas, Texas, has submitted an invoice to the City for support and licensing, effective July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025, in the amount of \$54,237.13.

> NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON LAKE, STATE OF OHIO:

Section No. 1: That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay to the Tyler Technologies, Inc., \$54,237.13 for the support and licensing of the City's financial software.

Section No. 2: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section No. 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the necessity of providing for licensed software and its support to ensure the orderly and efficient operation of the Finance Department to maintain the financial stability of the City, thus for the health, safety, and welfare of the public. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
